



# Surgical & Oncologic Pathology Fellowship

**Applications are invited for a 1 year Surgical and Oncologic Pathology Fellowship program in the Department of Pathology, Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital starting December 1, 2023.**

Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital is a 1000 bed tertiary care center. The Department of Pathology consists of ten well trained, experienced Histo/cytopathologists and Hematopathologists, with various subspecialty fellowships in both nationally and international training programs. Subspecialty reporting is performed based on the training and expertise of the pathologists. The department processes over 13,000 surgical specimens including frozen sections, and 3000 non-gyn, gyn cytology and FNAC specimens yearly, both tumor and non-tumor related. The department has a state of the art grossing room, automated instrumentation for processing specimens and a robust immunohistochemistry panel for aiding pathologic diagnosis. A well equipped molecular and cytogenetics lab with NGS sequencing, FISH analysis etc and flow cytometry are also part of the Department.

- The fellowship program will provide advanced in-depth training in both neoplastic and non-neoplastic pathology in various subspecialties including Head and Neck, Bone and Soft Tissue, GI, Breast, Gynecologic, Urinary, Thoracic, Endocrine, Skin and Neuropathology. Fellows will receive a wide exposure to various radical resections and biopsies, cytology specimens, referral cases, as well as intra-operative specimens (frozen sections).
- The fellow will be expected to be actively involved in grossing specimens, on-site cytology evaluations and fine needle aspiration biopsies, frozen sections, assisting in routine signouts and after hour/on-call duties when required. He/she will also be required to be involved in departmental and interdepartmental meetings, presentations including tumor boards, teaching, and research activities and contribute to publishing abstracts and peer reviewed papers.

**Requirements:** Postgraduates who have completed their training in Pathology (MD/DNB) in an accredited program and have passed the said examination within 4 years before commencing the fellowship program will be considered. There will be a written (MCQ/short question) test and interview for the selection process. Stipend will be communicated at time of selection. **Last date of application is October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023**
